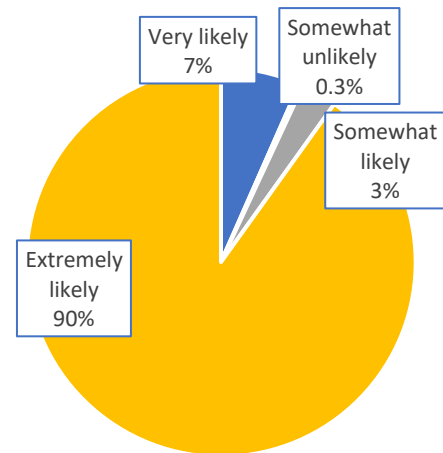




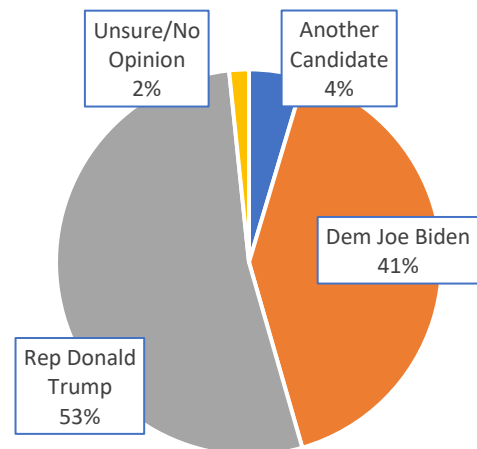
Q2. How likely are you to vote in the 2022 midterm General Election in North Carolina?

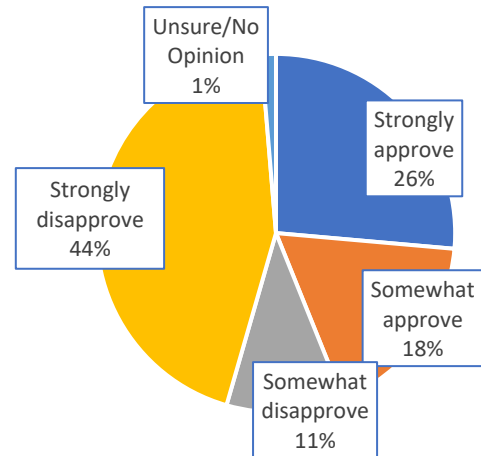
Q4. When thinking back to the 2020 General Election, did you vote for Republican Donald Trump, Democrat Joe Biden, another candidate, or did not vote?

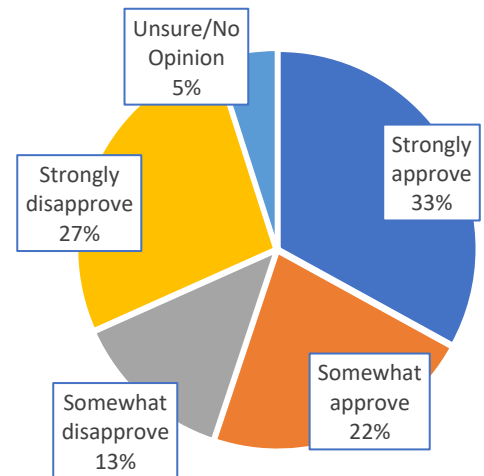

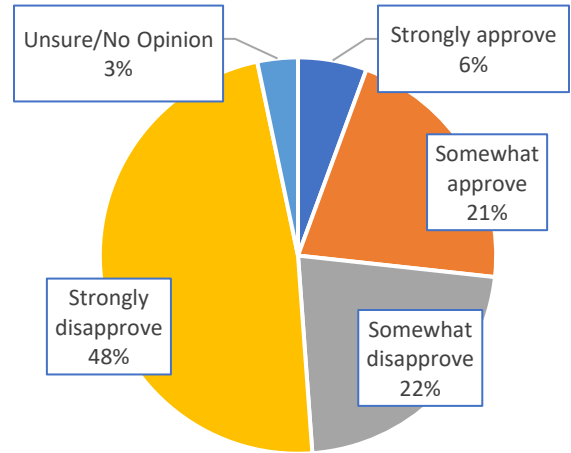

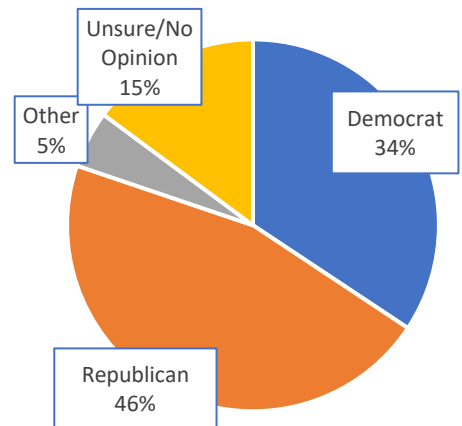

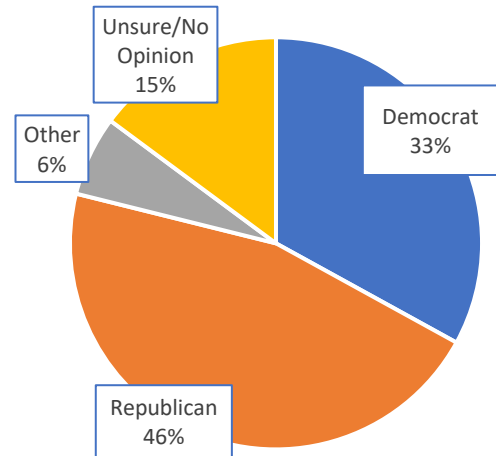
Q8. If the 2022 general election for U.S. Senate were held today, which party's candidate would you plan to vote for?

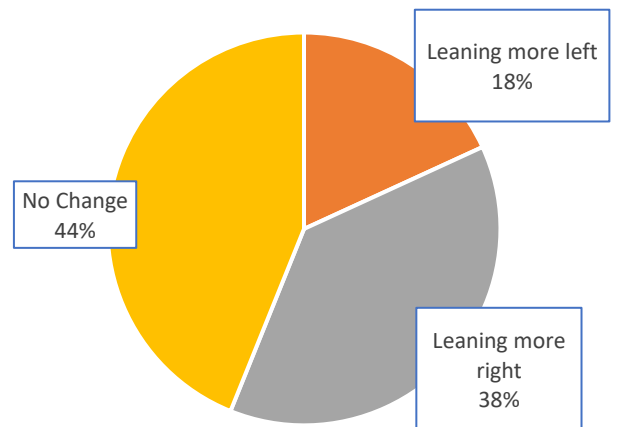
Q9. If the 2022 general election for North Carolina State Legislature were held today in the district you live in, which party's candidate would you plan to vote for?

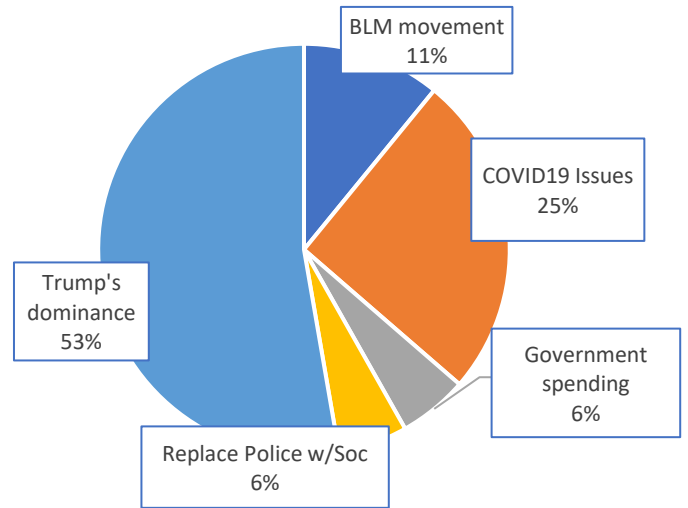
Q10. When thinking about your political ideology since January 1, 2021, do you find yourself leaning more to the left, to the right, or no change?

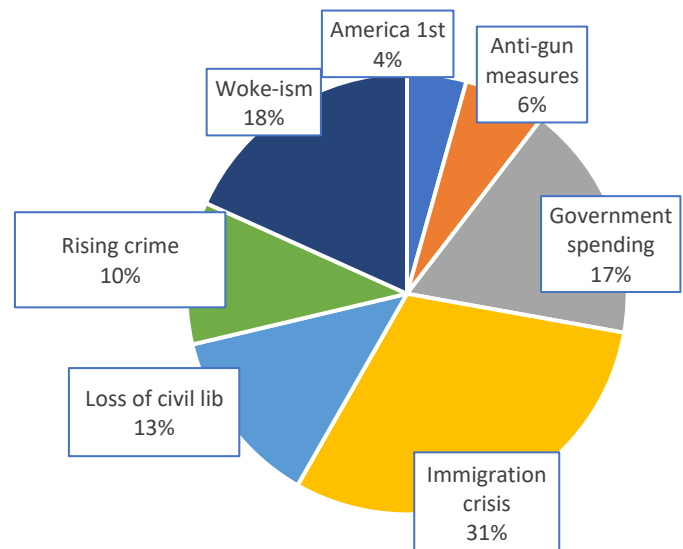

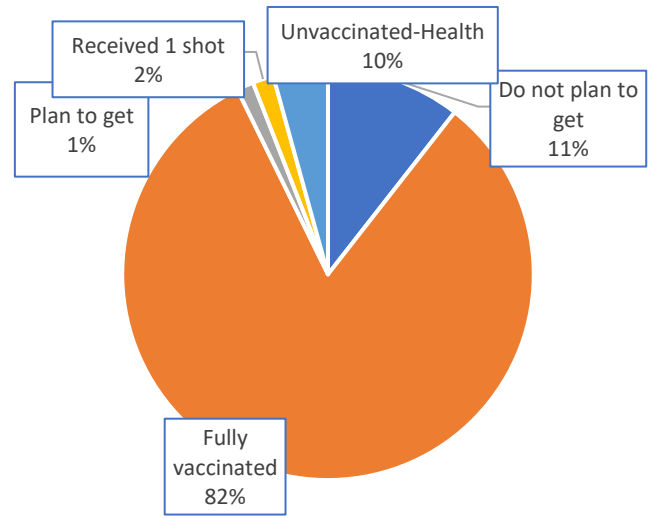

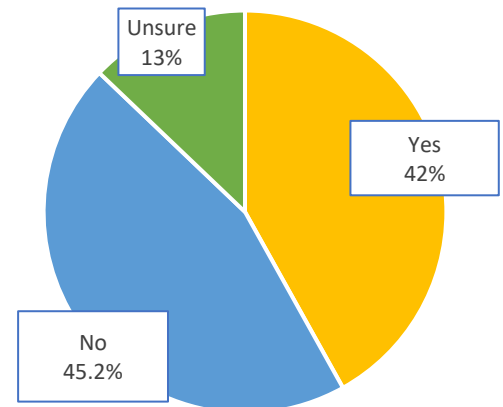

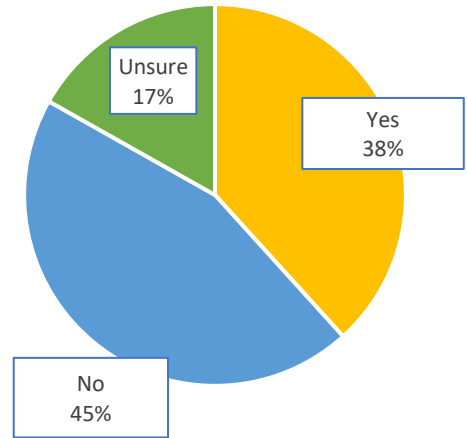
Q12. Do you believe the government should mandate the COVID19 vaccine for all adults who are eligible to receive the vaccine?

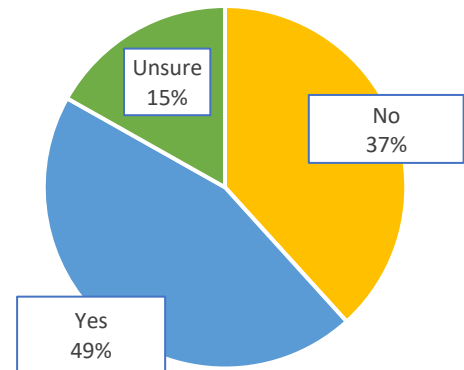
Q13. Do you believe the government has the power to mandate masks?

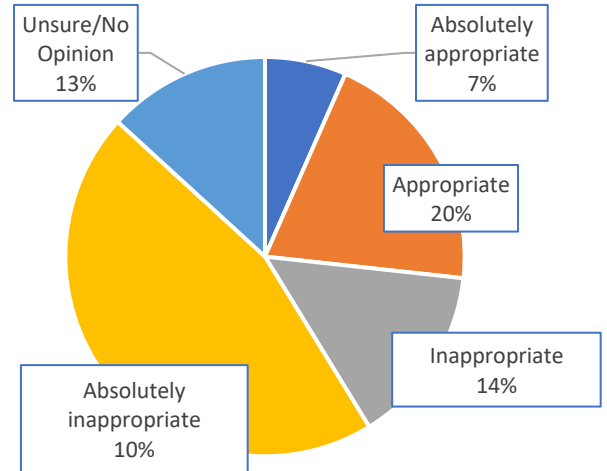
Q14. When considering the COVID Delta variant, do you think children under the age of 12 should be required to use a face mask in school?

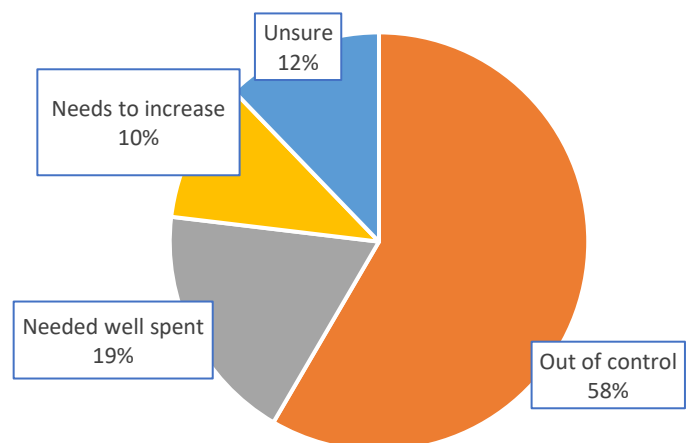

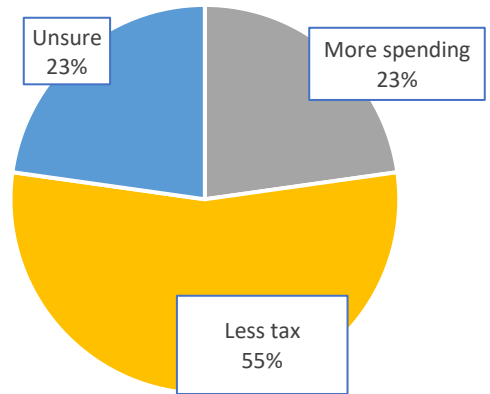

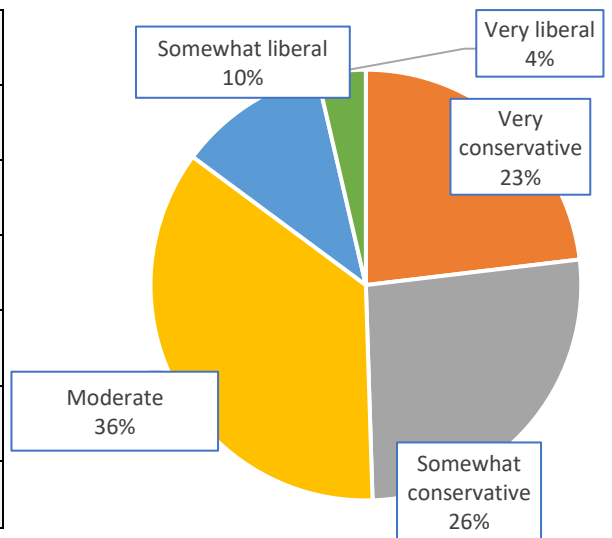
Q17. If the government had a choice between more spending on social services or less tax, which do you think it should do?

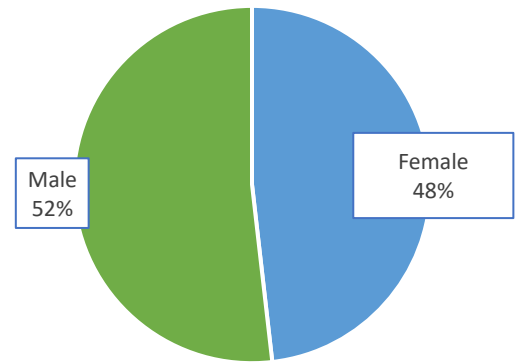
Q18. Do you consider yourself to be Very Conservative, Somewhat Conservative, Moderate, Somewhat Liberal or Very Liberal?

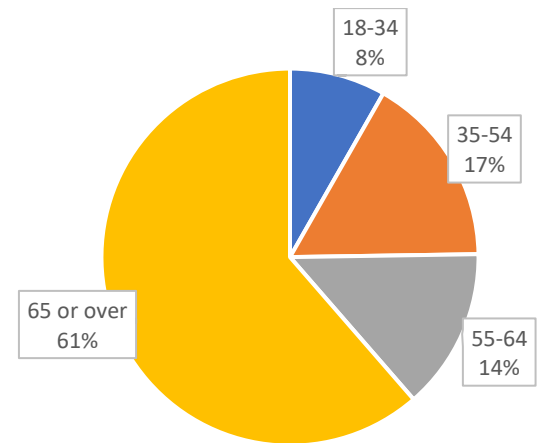

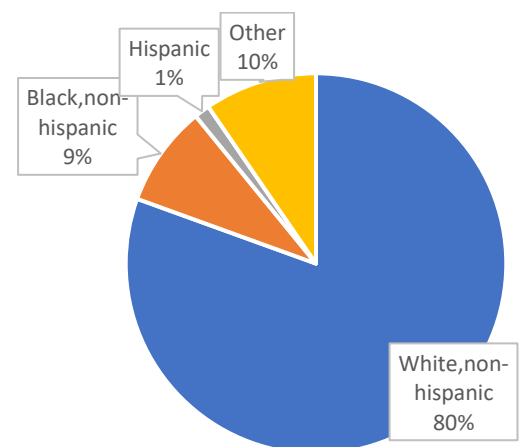

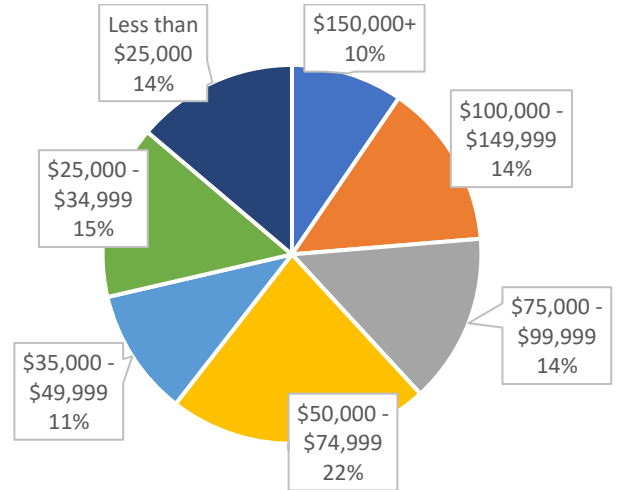
Q21. What is your Race or Ethnicity?
