COOPER, III, Governor of North Carolina, in his official capacity (herein after as "Governor Cooper"), by and through undersigned counsel, and respectfully moves the Court to dismiss Plaintiffs' Second Amended Complaint against Governor Cooper in the above-captioned matter pursuant to Fed.
