This matter is before the Court on the Plaintiff's Verified Complaint and Request for a Three-Judge Panel Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-267.1

N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-267.1 and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-1A, Rule 42(b)(4) of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure require that any action that is a facial challenge to the validity of an act of the General Assembly be transferred to a three-judge panel in the Superior Court of Wake County.

Plaintiff's Verified Complaint raises a facial challenge to the validity of acts of the General Assembly. There are no other pending issues in this case which can be addressed at this time without resolving the facial challenges. It is therefore ORDERED that the portions of this action challenging such acts are transferred to a three-judge panel of the Superior Court of Wake County, to be appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-267.1 and N.C. Gen. Stat. § 1-1A, Rule 42(b)(4) of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.
