1. Each party shall submit proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by 5:00 p.m. on April 9, 2025. All counsel and any self-represented parties shall be copied on the email submissions by the parties.

2. Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, and the parties' motions for summary judgment shall be heard by the Court at 10:00 a.m. on April 14, 2025, in Courtroom 3B of the Wake County Courthouse, 316 Fayetteville Street, Raleigh, NC. The Court intends to issue its ruling by May 1, 2025.

3. By oral consent of all members of the assigned three-judge panel, the Honorable Judge Edwin G. Wilson, Jr. may sign this Scheduling Order on behalf of all members of the assigned three-judge panel, and this Scheduling Order shall be given full force and effect as if all members of the assigned three-judge panel had signed their names hereto.
